Notice is hereby given that **Limekiln Wind Limited has been granted consent** under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 by the Scottish Ministers to construct and operate the Limekiln Wind Farm Extension, a wind powered electricity generating station comprising 5 wind turbines, each having a maximum blade tip height not exceeding 149.9 metres with a projected output of approximately 21 megawatts and battery storage of around 5 megawatts. It is located approximately 1.55 kilometres (“km”) south east of the village of Reay and 12.3 km west of Thurso within the planning authority area of Highland Council.

The Scottish Ministers have also directed, under Section 57(2) of the Town & Country Planning Act (Scotland) 1997, that planning permission is deemed to be granted for the development.
